Terms and Conditions of Entry

The Artwork

1. The entry theme for 2021 is "Water".
2. The entered artworks must be 2D artworks using any medium **excluding** photography, printmaking and digital artwork.
3. All artworks entered must be an original concept and uncopied work by the artist.
4. The entered artworks must be completed in the previous twelve months preceding the entry closing date and not previously shown or entered in any other competition/exhibition.
5. Only ONE artwork per artist will be accepted.
6. A completed entry form and payment must be received no later than the stated closing date.
7. The finished artwork, including frame, must be no larger than 600mm x 900mm.
8. No wet painting allowed. All artworks must be prepared to the exhibition standard - refer to item 10 on this section.
9. All entries must have attached these details on the reverse - lower right side: Title, Artist Name, Medium, Sale Price and Phone Number.
10. All entries must be suitably framed and have flat D rings with wire attached on the back ready for display. A stretched canvas is considered framed.

Entry Details

1. Break O'Day Local Art Prize (BODLAP) is open to permanent residents of Break O'Day Municipality only.
2. Prizes: Prize-winning Award of \$2,000. All exhibited entries are eligible for the People's Choice Award of \$500.
3. The artist must be 18yo or over.
4. Entries are now open.
5. A completed entry form must be submitted electronically via email to infoBODLAP@gmail.com on or before the closing date of Friday 30th April 2021. No late or incomplete entries will be accepted.
6. A non-refundable Entry fee of \$10 per artwork must be paid via EFT no later than the closing date of Friday 30th April 2021 to

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7. All artworks must be delivered to Portland Memorial Hall in St Helens on Thursday 11th June 2021, between 9am and 12pm.

8. All artworks must be collected from Portland Memorial Hall on Monday 14th June 2021 between 9am and 12pm.
9. Uncollected artworks will become the property of Bay of Fires Arts Association after one month from the specified date in item 8 on this section.
10. Voting of the People's Choice will close midday on Sunday 13th June 2021 to allow votes to be counted.
11. The Prizewinner and the People's Choice award will be announced at 2pm on Sunday 13th June 2021.

Acceptance and Exhibition

1. By completing the entry form, the artist agrees to and accepts these Terms and Conditions.
2. All reasonable care will be exercised in handling the submitted artworks, however Bay of Fires Arts Association will accept no responsibility and will not be held liable for any loss, damage or theft to any artworks in the exhibition. Artists are advised to insure their own work.
3. All entries must be for sale. A commission of 20% applies on all sales. The net sale proceeds will be paid to the artist within 14 business days of sale, provided settlement has been made in accordance with the conditions of sale.
4. Sold artworks can be collected at the end of the exhibition on Sunday. Otherwise, the artists will be responsible for the shipping and handling of the item to the purchaser.
5. Artists who have a registered ABN are responsible for their own GST compliance.
6. Bay of Fires Arts Association reserves all rights to refuse the display of any entry that fails to meet all requirements outlined in the terms and conditions of entry, or any artwork deemed to be unacceptable for exhibition.
7. Should the number of entries exceed the available displaying space, Bay of Fires Arts Association reserves the right to accept entries on a first come first served basis.
8. The exhibition judges will choose the prize-winning artwork from the accepted entries. The judges' decision will be final and correspondence will not be entered into.
9. The exhibition will be open to the public on Saturday 12th and Sunday 13th June 2021 between 10am to 3pm at Portland Memorial Hall, St Helens.
