Entry is open to all persons aged 4 - 18 years (Kindergarten—Grade 12) in 2024

Entrants are invite to explore, reflect and create on the following theme:

### "Ocean"

This theme encourages children and young people to explore the beauty of the ocean and it's ecosystem, to create artworks that showcases the ocean's flora and fauna, the impact of climate change on the ocean, or the importance of preserving the ocean's natural resources.

All entries must show consideration on, interaction with, and understanding of the theme. We encourage the submission of a range of Art forms: Drawing, Painting, Sculpture, Clay work, Photography, Printing, Textiles and multi media or sensory experiences

(see Terms & Conditions for details of film, moving images or digital sound piece entry)

#### **Terms and Conditions of Entry:**

- This art work has not been previously exhibited, including on-line
- All entries must give consideration to the hanging of their entry and ensuring that the style/weight and material are suitable easy wall hanging. Individual entries size limited to 100cm X 100cm.
- Entry is free with **one** entry per child or young person only (may participate in 1 group entry also)
- Digital works must be no more than 1 min in length and formatted as .mp4 or .mov or .avi files.
- Sound pieces must be no more than I min in length and formatted as .mp3 or .wav files
- Still images should still be printed and posted to us
- The artist agrees that BODRA and FVNH may use the work and the entry information. Art work will be accepted at the discretion of the organising committee
- The artist statement and profile have been completed
- Artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with artist name, age and school
- Group category must be K-6 only with 1 art work per group with a size limited 120x150 cm unless a soft/rollable material where a maximum of 3m x 1.5m accepted
