Terms and Conditions of Entry

The Artwork

1. The entry theme for 2024 is "Tranquillity".
2. The entered artwork must be 2 dimensional, within the category of fine arts using any medium **excluding** photography, printmaking or digital artwork.
3. All artwork entered must be an original concept and uncopied work by the artist.
4. The entered artwork must have been completed in the previous twelve months preceding the entry closing date and not previously shown or entered in any other competition/exhibition.
5. Only ONE artwork per artist will be accepted.
6. A completed entry form and payment must be received **no later** than the stated closing date.
7. The finished artwork, **including frame**, must be no larger than 90cm x 90cm.
8. No wet paintings allowed. All artwork must be prepared to the exhibition standard - refer to item 10 on this section.
9. All entries must have attached on the reverse - lower right side: Title, Artist Name, Medium, Sale Price and Phone Number.
10. All entries must be suitably framed and have flat D rings with wire attached on the back ready for display. A stretched canvas is considered framed.

Pages 2, 3, and 4 are to be kept by the artist.

Entry Details

1. Tasmania Shop Local Art Prize is open to permanent residents of Break O'Day Municipality only.
2. Prizes: Prize-winning Award of \$2,000. All exhibited entries are eligible for the People's Choice Award of \$500.
3. The artist must be 18 years old or over.
4. A completed entry form must be submitted electronically via email to infoBODLAP@gmail.com, or a hard copy handed in to reception at the **St Helens or Fingal Neighbourhood House**, on or before the closing date of **Friday 28th May 2024**.
5. **No late or incomplete entries will be accepted.**
6. A non-refundable entry fee of \$20 per artwork must be paid via EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) no later than the closing date of Friday 28th May 2024 to:

7. All artwork must be delivered to Panorama Hotel, 1 Quail Street, St Helens on **Wednesday 5th June 2024, between 8am and 12pm**.
8. All artwork unsold and sold artwork can be collected from Panorama Hotel, 1 Quail Street, St Helens on **Sunday 16th June 2024 between 2pm and 5pm and Monday 17th June 2024 between 8am and 10am**.
9. Uncollected artwork will become the property of Bay of Fires Arts Association after one month from the specified date in item 8 of this section.
10. The Purchaser is responsible for postage and handling.
11. Voting of the People's Choice will close at 2pm on Saturday 15th June 2024 to allow votes to be counted.
12. The People's Choice award will be announced on Sunday 16th June 2024 at 10am.
13. Artwork may be photographed by the event organisers specifically for event promotion and publicity purposes only.

Acceptance and Exhibition

1. By completing the entry form, the artist agrees to and accepts these Terms and Conditions.
2. All reasonable care will be exercised in handling the submitted artwork, however Bay of Fires Arts Association will accept no responsibility and will not be held liable for any loss, damage or theft to any artwork in the exhibition.
3. Artists are advised to insure their own work.
4. All entries must be for sale.
5. A commission of 20% applies on all sales. The net sale proceeds will be paid to the artist within 14 business days of sale, provided settlement has been made in accordance with the conditions of sale.
6. Sold artwork **MUST** be collected at the close of the exhibition on **Sunday 16th June 2024** between **2pm and 5pm** or on **Monday 17th June 2024** between **8am and 10am**.
7. Artists who have a registered ABN are responsible for their own GST compliance.
8. The local art group reserves all rights to refuse the display of any entry that fails to meet all requirements outlined in the terms and conditions of entry, or any artwork deemed to be unacceptable for exhibition.
9. Should the number of entries exceed the available displaying space, the local art group reserves the right to accept entries on a first in first served basis.
10. The exhibition judge(s) will choose the prize-winning artwork from the accepted entries. The judges' decision will be final and correspondence will not be entered into.
11. The exhibition will be open to the public from Saturday 8th to Sunday 16th June 2024 at Panorama Hotel, 1 Quail Street, St Helens.
